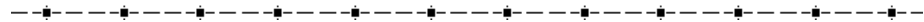

It is approximately 3 blocks north of the Hennepin Avenue Bridge and is located on the corner of 3rd Avenue NE and Main Street. A large free parking lot is next to the building.

Entrée descriptions:

Beef Tenderloin – Dijon and peppercorn encrusted beef tenderloin with a Dijon sauce

Salmon – grilled and served with a lemon basil sauce

Stuffed chicken – chicken stuffed with white/wild rice, candied pecan, and cranberry, served with plum chutney
